If you can't access the internet

How to find resources

- Dial 2-1-1 on your phone and ask about local payment assistance programs.
- Visit www.findhelp.org to search for resources by state.
- Visit websites for your local school district, internet providers, and community organizations to see if they offer internet access assistance.
- Visit www.digitalinclusion.org to see their list of free and low-cost internet plans offered by internet service providers.

Tips for rural internet challenges

- 1. Ask your neighbors how they get connected.
- 2. Ask your cellular service provider if you can use your mobile phone as a "hotspot."
- 3. Use your smartphone to search for possible providers.
- 4. Explore the option of satellite internet services.

SEARCH TIP: Search for "LTE internet access," "5G internet access," or "rural internet providers" + your city and state.
